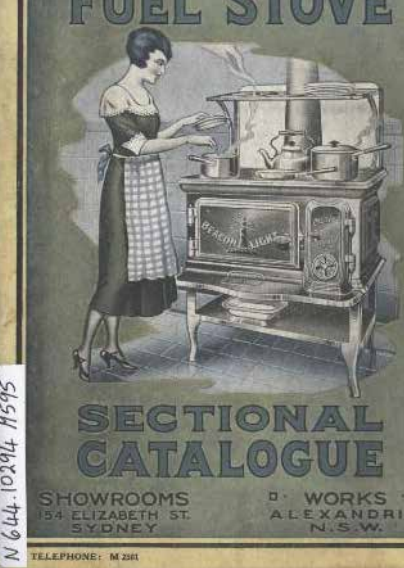

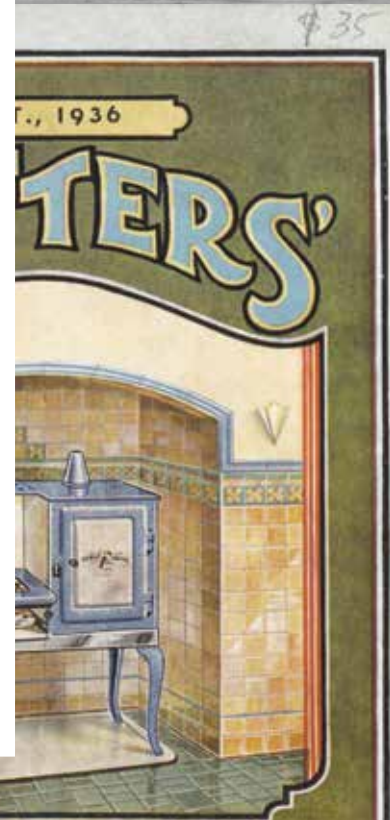
OUR STORY

LOWER EMISSIONS.

Australia's strict particulate matter emissions standards of 1.5g/kg have been vastly outperformed by our Kosi range. A Metters Kosi wood heater is a better choice than many other wood heaters to achieve cleaner air for you and Australia.

CARBON NEUTRAL.

Over its lifetime a tree absorbs a significant amount of carbon dioxide; when wood is burned, that same CO₂ is released back into the atmosphere where it can be re-absorbed by newly planted trees. When using wood from a sustainably managed source, your Metters Kosi does not contribute additional CO₂ to the Earth's carbon load.

VERMICULITE LINERS

The Kosi range has interlocking firebox liners made from high quality naturally fire-resistant vermiculite, keeping the firebox well insulated for a hotter, cleaner burn.

EMISSIONS RATING

A low emissions rating means the wood heater is producing fewer particulate matter emissions into the air. Choosing a wood heater with an emissions rating of 1.0g/kg or less, like the Kosi N^o.25, is an environmentally sound choice.

EXTERNAL ROOM AIR

Using air from outside to combust the fire improves efficiency and importantly, gives you better indoor air quality. An external room air system is a must for new homes, and ideal for well insulated rooms.

PULL-OUT ASH DRAW

The Kosi's convenient ash draw is concealed behind our magnetic-close door at the base of the wood heater. Fitted with a lid and carry handle, it makes ash removal a breeze!

With the addition of a 3 speed fan and RF remote, the radiant heat created the Kosi wood heater can be better controlled and distributed. The Radio Frequency (RF) remote capabilities means you can easily control your fan speed from anywhere in the room.

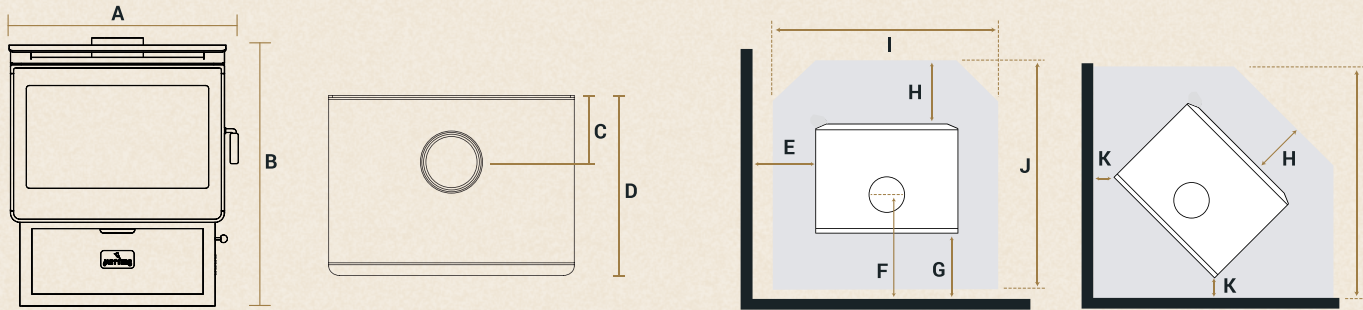
